



## Red Wines

1. **Spain;** Castillo Del Moro Tempranillo/Syrah 15 Glass- 175ml £5.50 250ml £6.50 £19  
A nice blend of the traditional Rioja grape with Shiraz, great light drinking
2. **France;** Les Vignerons Grenache Pinot Noir 15 Glass- 175ml £5.50 250ml £6.50 £19  
Black juicy fruits on nose the aromas of black cherry and white peppers of the Grenache
3. **Chile;** Santa Lucia Merlot 15 Glass- 175ml £5.50 250ml £6.50 £19  
Soft, fleshy and velvety with suave red berry fruit and a dash of spice
4. **Sicily;** Meridione Nero D'Avola 15 Glass- 175ml £5.50 250ml £6.50 £19  
This is a fine Sicilian grape, very under rated a great easy drinking, check out bin 10 for a single vineyard
5. **France;** Cotes du Rhone, Reserve de Fleur 14 Glass- 175ml £6.50 250ml £8.50 £22  
A lovely CDR, excellent drinking at this price
6. **Argentina;** Humberto Canale Malbec 15 (Landlord's choice) £26  
Vineyards situated in Rio Valley in patagonia and are among the most sothernly in the world
7. **California;** Bogle Petite Sirah 13 £26  
A soft Sirah from just south of the Napa Valley, more of a rhone style with lots of fruit
8. **Chile;** Leyda Pinot Noir Reserve 14 £26  
Clean and direct fruity nose with red cherries and a hint of wild herb note
9. **South Africa;** Ondine Cabernet Franc 10 £26  
A great single grape from Darling on the Western Cape, big and bold with plenty of fruit, the sirloin is waiting.
10. **Chile;** De Gras Carmenere (Landlord's choice) £26  
Carmenere is often confused with Merlot, more body in this and I prefer it to Merlot
11. **France;** Cotes du Rhone, Domain Brusset £27  
Lovely full and typical CdR
12. **Sicily ;** Planeta Plumbago Nero d Avola 14 £29  
From the banks of Lake Arincio, this single vineyard NdV is full on fruit and soft rounded tannins
13. **Australia;** Hollick The Bard Cabernet Sauvignon 13 (Landlord's choice) £30  
From the famous Coonawarra region in South Australia, you wont find a better Cab Sav for this money
14. **South Africa;** Thelema Shiraz 10 £35  
Big rich shiraz from Elgin which is east of Cape Town
15. **USA;** Barboursville Cabernet Franc Reserve 10 £35  
One of the blending grapes from Bordeaux, this is lovely as a single varietal
16. **New Zealand;** Yealands Estate Pinot Noir 14 £40  
An elegant yet complex pinot noir showing ripe fruit and floral characters
17. **Spain;** Lo Piot Priorat 08 £40  
A well priced Priorat and one of my favourite Spanish appellations SW of Barcelona
18. **Virginia USA;** Boxwood Cabernet/Merlot/Petit Verdot 10 £40  
Great Bordeaux blend and the petit verdot give this great structure (Landlords choice)
19. **South Africa;** Bouchard Finlayson The Hannibal 12 £45  
Hell of a blend, Sangiovese, Pinot Noir, Shiraz, Mourvedre, Nebbiolo, Barbera... tastes great
20. **Italy;** Ascheri Langhe Nebbiolo 14 £40  
One step below Barolo, this is one came in the top 3in a blind Barolo tasting
21. **France;** Domain Lencheneaut Nuits-Saint-Georges Cotes de Nuits 08 £45  
Lovely Burgundy form the Cote de Nuits, fantastic drinking at this price (Two only)
22. **Spain;** Marques de Grinon Petit Verdot 08 £45  
A fabulous wine from the Valdepus DO Pago in central Spain, big, bold and beautiful (Landlords choice)
23. **Australia;** Glaetzer Bishop Shiraz 13 £55  
A love rich, robust aussie Shiraz from Ben Glaetzer in the Barossa Valley.
24. **Spain;** Pago De Los Capellanes 12 £65  
Cracking wine from the Ribera Del Duero.
25. **France;** Chateau Feytit-Clinet Pomerol 01 £75  
On the right bank in Pomerol, 01 is one of their top vintages and drinking near its best.
